NHS offers tests to help find Cancer sooner.

Finding Cancer early means treatment is easier.

This is called the **National Cancer Screening Programme**.



Breast screening helps to find cancer early.



At the hospital the staff will check your breasts on a machine.



Breast screening is offered to:

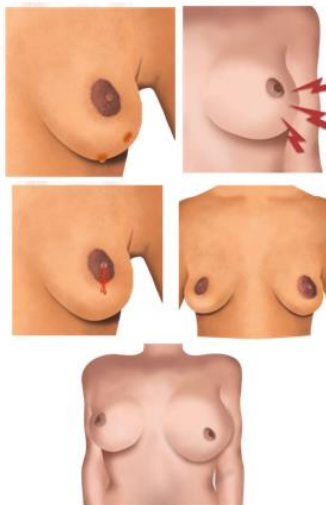
- Women
- Between the age of 50 – 70



Your GP will invite you for the Screening appointment every 3 years.



If you have symptoms of Breast Cancer like



- Lump in breast or armpit
- Pain in breast that does not go away
- Skin changes in breast that looks like orange peel or red
- Change in size of breast
- Nipples look different
- Liquid coming out of nipple



Do not wait for your next cancer screening appointment if you think you have symptoms.
